ADVANCED CARDIAC LIFE SUPPORT (ACLS) | 2024

Description

Advanced Cardiac Life Support is a course developed by the American Heart Association for the training of health care providers. It emphasizes the knowledge and skills necessary to provide appropriate early treatment for cardiopulmonary arrest. Additional areas of emphasis include the proper management of situations likely to lead to cardiac arrest and stabilization of the patient in the period following successful resuscitation. ACLS includes the use of adjunctive equipment and techniques for establishing and maintaining effective ventilation and circulation. In addition, this program reviews related pharmacology, management of acute coronary syndromes, stroke, and effective communication as a member and leader of a resuscitation team. Upon successful completion, participants are granted an ACLS provider card through the American Heart Association. Provider status is valid for two years, and a renewal course is required to remain an ACLS provider.

Objectives

Upon completion of the ACLS course the participant will be able to:

- Recognize and initiate early management of periarrest conditions that may result in cardiac arrest or complicate resuscitation outcome.
- Demonstrate proficiency in providing BLS care, including prioritizing chest compressions and integrating AED use.
- ⁿ Manage cardiac arrest until return of spontaneous circulation, termination of resuscitation or transfer of care.
- ⁿ Identify and treat ischemic chest pain and expedite the care of patients with acute coronary syndromes.
- Recognize other life-threatening clinical situations, such as stroke, and provide effective initial care and transfer to reduce disability and death.
- Demonstrate effective communication as a member or leader of a resuscitation team and recognize the impact of team dynamics on overall team performance.

Prerequisites

 Required: Participants must complete the Precourse Self-Assessment and achieve a score of at least 70% before taking the ACLS course. Participants must email completion certificate prior to class to participate (or bring printed certificate of completion to class).

- 2. Participants must pick up and review the ACLS Provider Manual prior to class attendance.
- 3. Participants should have basic EKG interpretation and pharmacology knowledge. These are not taught in class.
- 4. Participants must demonstrate CPR/BLS proficiency to complete the class.
