

We handle the paperwork for you

Hospice requires a provider referral and certification that the patient has a life-limiting diagnosis of six months or less. Hospice care is covered 100 percent by Medicare and Medicaid and is usually covered by private insurance. Our social workers can assist in determining coverage and payment options. We will file the necessary paperwork with your insurance provider. Patients are never turned away based on the inability to pay.

Hospice is an intensification of the type of compassionate medical care that provides management of pain in all areas of life. It focuses on comfort rather than cure, helping patients toward emotional and spiritual healing as they work through the experience of illness and death. It is a privilege to help people toward that goal.
